FRENSHIP BRACELET INSTRUCTIONS

You'll need:

embroidery thread

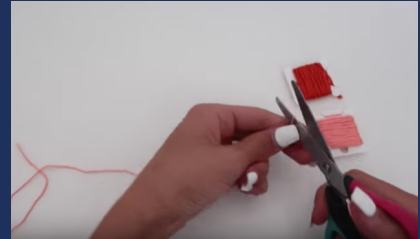
scissors

tape or pins/safety pins

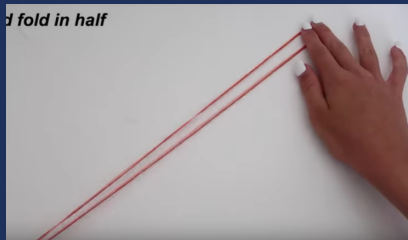
STEP 1 Pick 2-6 embroidery thread colours



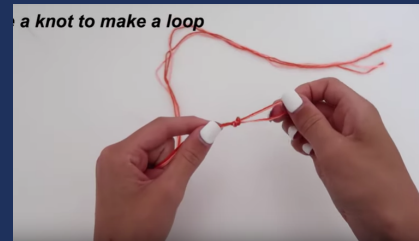
STEP 2 Cut an arms length of the threads chosen in step 1



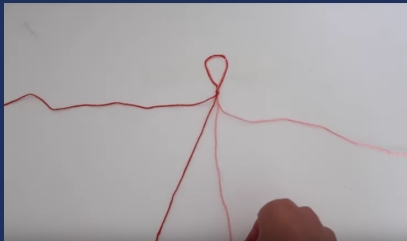
STEP 3 Group all the threads together and fold in half



STEP 4 Tie a knot at half way to make a loop (now you should have two of each colour chosen)

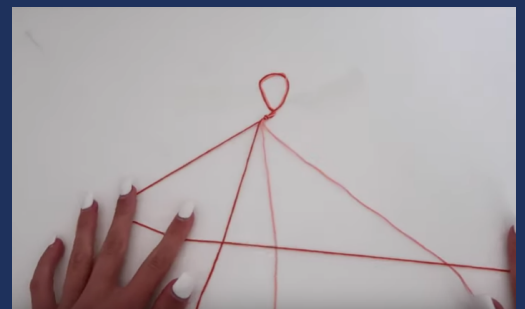


STEP 5 Tape the loop to the table and separate all of the threads



STEP 6 Using the furthest left thread make the number "4" over the second thread to the left. Pull the end of the first thread under the second thread and through the hole of the "4" to create a knot.

Repeat this knot.



STEP 7 Using the same thread, repeat Step 6 on the remaining threads (remember to knot twice on each string!)



STEP 8 Repeat step 6 and 7 except now using what used to be the second thread.



STEP 9 Tie a knot using all of the threads. Cut about 5cm after this knot. Tie onto your friends wrist!
